

MOTORISED TRANSPORT

Use of Motorised Transport is **NOT** permitted for **players** at any BOP fixture except that motorised transport may be permitted, for reasons of medical or physical disability, **on production** of a current medical certificate and with the agreement of the Host Club / District.

Unless the conditions of a competition state a specific time limitation "Current" in this policy shall mean not more than 12 months prior to the date of the event.

Interdistrict Events: These events are usually played as trials for NZ Golf events (e.g. Interprovincial and Masters) and players are competing for places in the representative teams. Motorised transport is **Not** permitted for players at Inter District events except that, where a player has obtained a NZ Golf Exemption to use Motorised Transport within the 12 months preceding the BOP event, such exemption will apply at the BOP event.

Please note that at NZ Golf Events played at Club / District level (Club Teams, Home Links & Rosebowl) the NZ Golf Policy on Motorised Transport applies.

NZ Golf Motorised Transport Policy is in the NZ Golf Club Manual and should be studied carefully. (Constitution & Policies section)

Briefly a player cannot use motorised transport for a NZ Golf event unless they have applied for and gained an exemption certificate from NZ Golf.

For Home Links events (including 9 Hole Home Links) enforcement of NZ Golf Policy is up to the individual Clubs.

At the Club Teams District Finals and at the Rosebowl event the NZ Golf exemption certificate will need to be produced, to the BOP Executive responsible for the day, before commencement of play.
